

Local Competition Grant Application Form



Due to the unusual nature of this summer's track and field season because of the Coronavirus pandemic, England Athletics have cancelled all Championship events. We are seeking to partner up with local competition providers to help facilitate competition at a local level.

England Athletics will provide a limited grant of up to £500.00. This grant will primarily support competition providers with the costs of adapting their competition environment to ensure it is Covid-19 secure. Please see the competition schedule attached to this document to identify the competitions we will be looking to fund.

We appreciate that across the country there is disparity, but we will attempt, where possible, to ensure that there is equal competition coverage to keep travel to a minimum for competitors, guests and officials, hence the framework we are working within.

The competition provider must ensure that all competitors taking part in competitions with a grant provided by England Athletics are registered with England Athletics for the current season.

Funded competition begins on the week ending the 9th August and will continue until the 27th September. All competitions will require a Level 1 license and therefore must be held at a facility working towards trackmark.

- Other innovative solutions such as marketing, and equipment upgrade.
